Camp Overview

Open to rising 7th through 9th graders, this camp is designed to offer ballplayers with a desire to play at the highest level of high school baseball an opportunity to be instructed and evaluated by the Hardin Valley Academy baseball staff and other college coaches. The instructors used at this camp have gained a great reputation for the structured instruction they provide. In addition to one on one individual baseball instruction in all phases of the game, this camp will also provide video analysis of both hitting and pitching for each player. Players will also have the opportunity to participate in a pro-style defensive workout, showcase batting practice, and have their 60-yard dash time recorded. The instructional staff will also be conducting instructional seminars on the mental side of the game as well as informational sessions on the college recruiting process. On the final day of camp players will participate in live coach-pitch simulated games.
